



When Is a Medical Clearance Letter Needed?

- Absence: related to a medical condition > 3 days
- Ambulance was called to the school/home and transported your child
- Anaphylaxis: recent or new diagnosis
- Cancer diagnosis
- Chicken pox diagnosis
- COVID diagnosis: prolonged, severe symptoms or hospitalization
- Cocksackie diagnosis
- Concussion diagnosis-activity restrictions until cleared
- Diabetes: new diagnosis or recent hospitalization
- Fifth's disease, (Parvovirus B19) is diagnosed
- Hospitalization including ER visit
- Meningitis diagnosis
- Referral to your doctor for evaluation from school.
- Return to school with supportive device: ace wrap, cast, crutches, sling, wheelchair, etc.
- Respiratory Syncytial Virus, (RSV) is diagnosed
- Trauma needing immediate medical attention, i.e. car accident, fall, injury, sutures/stitches, etc.
- Seizures: new or uncontrolled onset
- Shingles diagnosis
- Surgery: Recent
- Tuberculosis diagnosis
