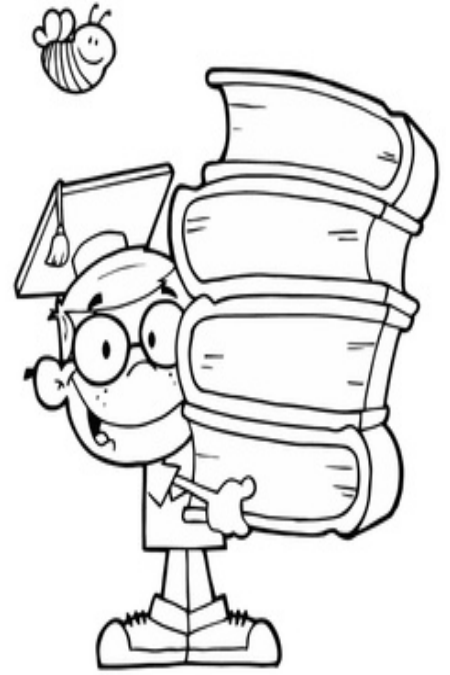


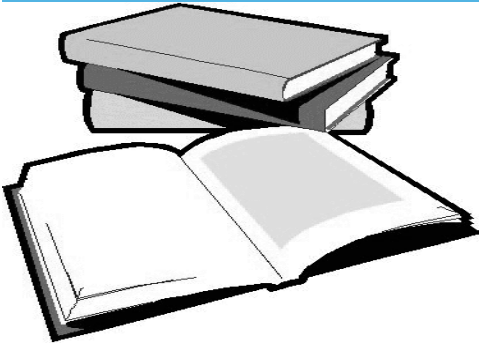

Classroom Activity:

A Lesson in Economy and Future Responsibility

- Each month the students will have to pay rent for their seats. The students will have to earn Morales Dollars by behaving well and by doing certain jobs.
- Rent will be due on the last day of each month. Rent is 50 Morales Dollars.
- Students will receive Morales Dollars daily. The following are ways they can earn Morales Dollars.
 - Daily good behavior (Students need to stay on good behavior or anything above)- **\$1**
 - Completing homework- **\$1**
 - Getting an A/100 on a test- **\$2**
 - Asking/Answering higher order thinking questions-**\$1**
 - Weekly Star student-**\$5**
 - Student of the Month-**\$10**
 - Classroom Job- **\$5**
- Morales Dollars can be taken away/deducted if the student:
 - Are disrespectful to the teacher or a student (**-\$1**)
 - Does not come to school prepared (**-\$1**)
 - Does not behave: (**-\$1**)
 - On line
 - At lunch
 - During prep
- What happens if the student does not have the rent money at the end of the month? If the student does not have enough Morales Dollars by the end of the month this would suggest that the student was not meeting the schools expectations or class/school rules.
 - 3 things will occur
 - Call home.
 - Lunch Detention.
 - Student will be designated to another seat.
 - The student still needs to pay the rent. During their probationary week they will need to follow all the rules and take self-responsibility for all their actions in order to earn the missing money. During this week they will have many opportunities to earn Morales Dollars.
