

Algebra 1 Frequently Asked Questions

How long is the Algebra 1 Regents Exam?

The Algebra 1 Regents exam lasts for <u>three hours</u>, although finishing the exam in less than three hours is possible. However, students should not expect to be allowed to leave the testing site before the threehour deadline has been met. What is the format of the Algebra 1 Regents Exam? The Algebra 1 regents contains four parts including both multiplechoice questions and constructed response questions. Part I contains 24 multiple choice questions, while Parts II, III, and IV contain constructed response questions.

How many questions are on the Algebra 1 Regents Exam? There are a total of 35 questions on the Algebra 1 Regents Exam. However, all of the questions are not weighted the same.

As of January 2018, students are required to earn 30 total credits to get a passing score of 65.

Students are permitted to use a **graphing** calculator on all sections of the Algebra 1 Regents exam. Students will also be given a reference sheet, a pencil, and a blue or black pen. All work on the test should be written in pen, except for graphs and drawings, which should be done in pencil only.
