Supply List for First Grade

1 backpack (without wheels) Please write your child's name inside the bag.

1 lunchbox and water bottle	1 personal dry erase board 9x12

2 Composition notebooks Please write your child's first and last name on the book. Please do not purchase the plastic covered composition notebook. It is too hard for the children to keep open while writing.

1 Primary picture journal Please write your child's first and last name on the book

2 boxes of Crayola 16 count crayons one for school and one for home

12 glue sticks

1 safety scissor

24 sharpened # 2 yellow pencils and 1 eraser

1 set of headphones – Please remove from the packaging and label them with your child's name.

1 pencil case: The pencil case should be able to hold 3 sharpened pencils, 1 box of crayons, 1 scissor, 1 glue stick, and an eraser. Please place the items inside the pencil case.
