## **Mandatory Summer Reading**

## ECE English 101 & 102

**Directions:** While reading *The Lincoln Highway*, by Amor Towles, annotate each chapter. If you are able to purchase the book, you may annotate in the book. Annotating in the book includes notes in the margin, not just highlighted lines. If you are using a digital or e-book copy, you may take notes on separate paper. If you are using a library book, you may use sticky note tabs or separate paper.

Notes should include the following elements for each chapter:

- Characterization- How have the characters grown or changed in this chapter? (This would mean highlighting lines that show characterization and labeling as such. The same is true for each element below.).
- Conflicts- Describe how internal or external conflicts are developed or resolved. (This would mean highlighting events that would create or further develop conflicts, and labeling as such.)
- Setting- How has the setting changed and what is the significance of where they are?
- Quotes- Quotes of significance should be included for each chapter.

Upon return to school in September, you will have an in-class writing assignment which will count as your first grade. Annotations and notes will be permitted as reference for that task.
