

## 8th Grade:

In order to keep your children safe in school, Medical and Nursing Services has developed some helpful information for the start of your child's school year. Having these necessary documents will help keep your child as safe as possible and will avoid exclusion from school and delays for participation in gym, recess, field trips and athletics.

## For all 8th Grade students, the following need to be submitted to your School Nurse:

**Physical Exam**: Completed on the NYS required form, ideally within 12 months of the start of the academic school year: **Physical Form Needed**

DTaP/DTP/Tdap/Td	3*
Tdap	1*
Hepatitis B	3*
Meningitis (MenA,C,W,Y)	1
MMR	2
Polio	4*
Varicella	2
