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Entrance Requirements

Entrance Requirements OVERVIEW There are four components: (1) Personal statement (2) Authentic Creative Art Project (3) Two Letters of Recommendation (4) Grade Point Average

Personal Statement

Personal Statement must explain:

- 1. Who are you as an artist?
- 2. Why are you a good candidate for RHA?
- 3. Description and explanation of the Authentic Creative Art Project

Authentic Creative Art Project Artwork can take any form such as:

- Paintings
- Models
- Dioramas
- Films
- Storyboards
- Acting/Dance performances
- Podcasts
- Personal videos
- Musical compositions or performances



Authentic Creative Art Project A piece of art based on one theme: 1.Community 2.Family 3.Nature **4.**Relationships 5.Universe



Authentic Creative Art Project GUIDING QUESTIONS (select ONE):

- How does my artwork relate to me or help to tell my personal story?
- How does my artwork make me feel?
- How does my artwork help me to tell a story, or does it make me think of a story worth telling?
- Does my artwork make me think of something from the past, present or future that is important to me or to others I know?



Authentic Creative Art Project

Focus on quality over quantity!

Video or audio work should be no longer than <u>3 mins</u>.



Letters of Recommendation

All applicants need **two (2)** letters of recommendation for consideration to RHA.

Both letters will focus on how the applicant's work as a student aligns to the mission and vision of RHA.



Grade Point Average

Applicants' Grade Point Average will be reviewed but it is not a determining factor in the admission decision.
