To go with Mo Willems' Books:

<u>Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the</u> <u>Bus,</u> <u>Don't Let the Pigeon Stay up</u> <u>Late,</u> <u>Pigeon Finds a Hot Dog,</u> <u>Pigeon Stays up Late</u>

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After reading <u>The Pigeon Finds a Hot Dog</u>, use the circle map to brainstorm different condiments the pigeon might want to put on his hot dog.
