#### **CELEBRATION OF LIFE: MR. JOSEPH COTTER**

Joseph Cotter was one of the region's most successful and prolific real estate developers. A true pioneer, Mr. Cotter transformed the former Otis Elevator industrial complex in Yonkers into i.Park Hudson, a thriving workplace that now includes the new Great Point Studios TV and film production complex. He collaborated with partners at Great Point Studios to launch a multi-million dollar development, significantly changing the landscape of film and television production in Westchester and New York State. This venture features over 16 soundstages and the Robert Halmi Sr. Academy of Film and Television, a public high school for grades 6 through 12.

On October 25, Mr. Cotter passed away suddenly at the age of 66. A memorial celebrating his life and the tremendous impact he had on both the industry and the region was held on November 9, 2024 at the Robert Halmi Sr. Film & Television Academy campus.






# THE DEAR AMERICA PROJECT


